Northumberland is set to be thrust into the limelight once again as film crews descend on a well-known beauty spot in an isolated part of the county.







## **Tips, Tricks & Advice**

- Add as much information and descriptions to your profile as possible
- Always add images to your location record ensure they are clear images of the space, room by room (don't worry if they're aren't glossy!)
- Try and have a member of the team dedicated to filming great to add general mailboxes, but productions depend on a sole filming friendly contact
- Reep your records up to date, renew line of contacts if they change in-house, add new images if anything changes at the location etc
